Jonah 4

APPLICATION

- Check the condition of your heart.
- "Those people"
- Who is worthy?

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

Read Jonah 4:1-4

Selfishness is the root of all sin.

1 Have you ever blamed God for your circumstances? What does His Word say about His character? (Refer to verse 2.)

Read Jonah 4:5-11.

If I don't think someone is worthy of God's grace, what makes me worthy of God's grace?

2 Due to Jonah's pride and prejudice, he could not rejoice that an entire nation had repented. Can you relate? What does God's Word say about having a "me" vs. "them" mentality? (John 3:16-17, 2 Corinthians 5:16-19)

3 How did God use the plant, the worm, and the wind to teach Jonah?

4 Reflecting on the events in Jonah's life, at what point do you find yourself most relating to right now?

1. On the boat, running in the opposite direction of where God is calling you
2. In the fish, asking for mercy and declaring Jesus's lordship in your life
3. Living in Ninevah, needing to repent and ask God's forgiveness
4. Under the shade of the plant, wanting mercy for yourself but not for others
5. Allowing God to transform you (more of Jesus, less of Jonah)

PAUSE, PONDER, PRAY - CONDITION OF THE HEART

Give thanks for God's grace, shown to you in Jesus. Give thanks that He continues to pursue you even when you struggle with pride and prejudice. Pray for God to bring your heart into sync with His, and to fill you with compassion for lost people. Share the names of one or two people you want God's help to love this week.
