- 1) Tyranny of the urgent
- 2) Jesus is the only way

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

Read Luke 16:19-31.

Hell is both a place and a condition, a relentless regret. (Matt. 5:29-30, 13:42, 25:41-46; Mk. 9:43-48)

1 What was the main issue about the rich man that Jesus is wanting us to see?

2 What do the rich man's words communicate about how he views himself, Lazarus, and God?

Read 1 Timothy 2:3-4, 2 Peter 3:9.

Hell was not created for people. It was created for satan and his demons. God does not send people to hell. He wants us to choose Him, but does not force us to choose Him.

3 What awesome attribute of God do we learn from the following scriptures: Daniel 7:9-10, Hebrews 12:28-29, Romans 8:37-38, and Romans 12:20-21?

Read Genesis 4:16, Jonah 1:3, and Romans 2:5-8.

The choice is ours.

4 Who are you burdened for who does not know Jesus? Take a moment to intercede for them as a group. (Names can remain anonymous.)

PAUSE, PONDER, AND PRAY

The love of God is relentless in pursuing us (Romans 8:37-38) and bridges the gap to eternal life (John 14:6). The love of God is eternal (Psalm 136). We are saved to Him, but we are also saved from hell. How is God calling you to be less passive and more proactive in sharing the message of eternity?
