QUESTIONS

Read Mark 4:13-20.

We are not in control of many things, but we ARE in control of the seed we sow.

- 1). What does Jesus' question in verse 13 tell you about the importance of this parable?
- 2). Give a testimony of when a faithful seed, sown in good soil, has produced a harvest. Where/how do you see the abundance today?

Read Genesis 8:22 and Galatians 6:7.

If you don't like the harvest you are reaping, then it's time to change the seed you are sowing.

- 3). Let's learn from one another! Share ways that you are sowing into: Your relationship with God - Your marriage - Your family - Your church.
