QUESTIONS

1). How does Isaiah 43:18-21 speak to your heart? What "new thing" has God been revealing to you recently?

Scriptures about DISHONOR: Genesis 9:18-25; Isaiah 14:12; Romans 1:21-22

People don't care how much you know (intellectual ascent) until they know how much you care (they are honored by you).

2). According to these scriptures, what are we doing when we dishonor someone?

3). Think of someone you are currently struggling to honor. Take a moment and silently pray for that person.

Scriptures about HONOR: Psalm 15:33; John 13:3-5

4). An excellent way to honor others is to invite them in your home. How have you shown the hospitality of honoring people or experienced it on the receiving end?
